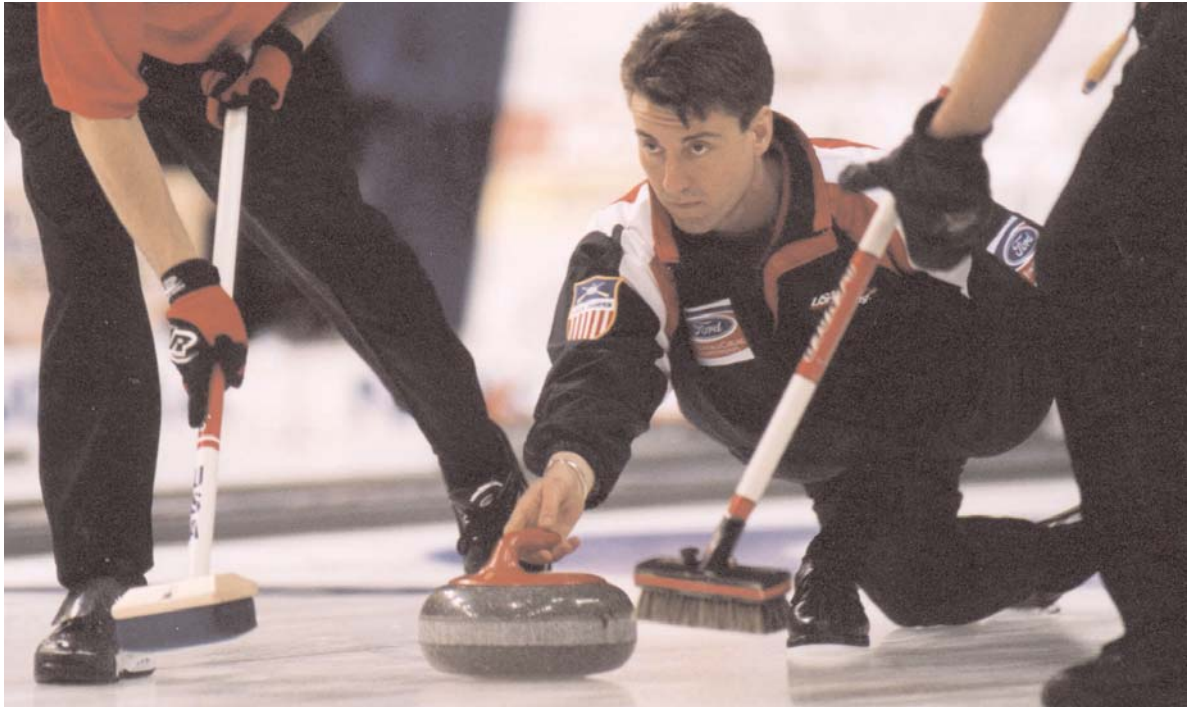

What is curling?

Curling is a winter sport played on an indoor sheet of ice about 135 feet long and 14 feet wide. The object for each four-person team is to slide 40 lb. curling 'stones' from one end of the sheet to the other. The team whose stone is closest to the center of the house scores a point(s).

Curling lasts a lifetime. Curlers range from five years old to 85. Curling offers opportunities for children, teens and adults in competitive and non-competitive leagues.
